


Pathway to Care for Child and Youth Mental Health Services

Children and Youth Mental Health Services

North Eastern Ontario Family and Children's Services (NEOFACS) offers a number of programs and services for children, youth and families experiencing mental health difficulties, crisis situations, family breakdowns, or complex and/or special needs. Specifically, resources, such as case management, intervention, or Psychiatric and/or Psychological services are offered. A comprehensive assessment directs treatment options. The length and types of services offered depends on the nature of the presenting issues.

- Counselling and Therapy Services
- Crisis Support Services
- Family Preservation Program
- Intensive Service Coordination
- Psychiatry and Psychological Services
- Residential Programs

GLOSSARY OF TERMS

ASIST: Applied Suicide Intervention Skills Training

BCFPI: Brief Child and Family Phone Interview (for child/youth 6 and over)

CTS: Counselling and Therapy Services

CYMH: Child and Youth Mental Health

FPP: Family Preservation Program

Harm to Others: Serious threats or harmful actions towards others

PHIPA: Ontario Act that governs the collection, use and disclosure of personal health information by health information custodians (www.ontario.ca/laws/statute/04p03)

Primary Services: Services that can be accessed by referral from the Intake Department

Secondary Services: Child/youth or caregiver must be involved in a Primary ServiceFPP: Family Preservation Program

Self-Harm: Deliberately hurting oneself

Suicidal Thoughts: Thinking about or planning suicide
