## **Responsibilities:**

- Set-up of booths, tables, chairs, tents, etc.;
- Attending Agency events and providing support and coverage for booths/activities; and,
- Distributing promotional items, refreshments, or information packets.

#### **Qualifications:**

- Computer skills, knowledge of MS Word;
- Neat and personable;
- Non-judgmental;
- Patient and relates well to children;
- Ability to cope in a busy environment; and,
- Respect for confidentiality.

In some cases, a valid driver's license, clear driver's abstract and proof of adequate insurance are required. Volunteers are compensated for local drives.
