A Special Friend is a Volunteer who develops a one-to-one relationship with a child or youth receiving services from NEOFACS. This volunteer is a positive role model who encourages personal growth, increased resiliency and self-esteem through shared interest activities. This program involves a regular commitment, ideally once a week and is open to individuals and couples.

Responsibilities:

- Offer support and can relate to the client on a one-to-one basis;
- Provide assistance with budgeting, homemaking, shopping, and other related life skills;
- Participate in activities that the child/youth enjoys and is willing to discover new activities with the child/youth;
- Familiarize clients with available community resources; and,
- Establish a caring, non-professional relationship with the family.

Qualifications:

- Mature and responsible;
- Confident, non-judgmental and patient;
- Enjoys the company of children/youth;
- Ability to engage with the worker, parent or foster parent as well as the child;
- Good writing skills;
- Neat and personable;
- Willingness to listen; and,
- Respects confidentiality.

In some cases, a valid driver's license, clear driver's abstract and proof of adequate insurance are required. Volunteers are compensated for local drives.
